Meal Pricing & Applications for Free or Reduced-Price Meals

We're pleased to inform you that the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) has provided guidance that all enrolled students within the Owen J. Roberts School District will receive a free breakfast for the entire school year through the School Breakfast Program (SBP), regardless of income! In addition, students who qualify for reduced-price meals will also receive lunch at no cost for the entire school year.

BREAKFAST: FREE FOR ALL STUDENTS! LUNCH:

For students not eligible for free lunch meals, the prices are as follows:

Elementary Schools: \$3.15

Middle School: \$3.50

High School: \$3.70

Free and Reduced Meal Applications

We encourage **ALL** families to submit a free and reduced-price meal application. It's quick, confidential, and helps support school funding. Apply online at www.schoolcafe.com or in person at your school office. The grace period for submitting applications has been extended to **October 8, 2025**. Be sure to reapply before this deadline.

Special Dietary Needs and Allergy/Medical Conditions

If your child has a food allergy or medical condition, please send a written doctor's note to the school nurse. For dietary substitutions, federal regulations require a written doctor's note. The nurse will forward this information to food service personnel, and it will be entered into our POS system to alert cashiers discreetly. Our Breakfast & Lunch Program

Breakfast: Students must take **at least 3 items**—and one must be a **fruit or veggie**—to get the full meal price.

Lunch: Students must choose **3 or more items** from our meal options, and one must be a **fruit or veggie**.

If a student doesn't meet these requirements, items will be charged **a la carte** (individually). This helps us serve meals that meet nutrition guidelines and keep things fair for everyone!

Account Payments and Policies

Payment Methods:

To keep our meal lines running smoothly and efficiently, we encourage families to use SchoolPay, our secure online payment system, to add funds to student meal accounts. Details on all available payment options, including any applicable fees, can be found on the foodservice website or by contacting the food service office.

PIN & Account Info

Every student gets a PIN for cafeteria purchases. Until it's memorized, they can simply give their name at checkout. Don't worry — their student photo helps us confirm the account. Account balances roll over automatically each year, so there's no need to transfer funds!
